## Guidelines for Effective Use of www.exam.net

## Dos & DON'Ts

- 1. Students have to visit the webpage: http://www.exam.net
- 2. In the home page there would be two options: Student & Teacher. Students have to select the Student tab.
- 3. Once they click on the student tab, then it would ask for the Exam key. The Exam key would be available in the schools website before the commencement of the exam.
- 4. The students will enter the Exam Key in the designated place and then enter their First Name, Last Name, Class and Admission Number.
- 5. After entering the details, students would click on Fetch The Exam button.
- 6. The main window will open and a message would be displayed "The exam is ready.""You are not allowed to leave the exam, and your teacher will be notified if you do so". The students have to click on Begin Exam button.
- 7. On doing this the entire window will shift to a **FULL SCREEN MODE** and students are not allowed to switch to any other window unless they do the Final Submission.
- 8. The window consists of three parts: Left Panel, Top Panel and Bottom Panel.
- 9. Left Panel: Consists of the student's name, other details like Show Exam, Teacher Chat, Submit examon the top followed by the TIMER CLOCK which will automatically start as soon as the student enters the window. The clock will display the time that has been officially allotted for the exam. And by default will freeze on 00.00. Hence students have to ensure that they complete the exam in the stipulated time and do the final submission subsequently.
- 10. Students have to begin the exam at the designated time mentioned, because the countdown of the clock timer will start automatically. Any delay in the login will be a loss for the individual only.
- 11. Top Panel:Consists of all the questions for that particular subject.
- 12. Bottom panel: the area where students have to type the answers.
  In the Answer area, students have to type their Name, Class, Section and Roll Number positively before answering the questions. It is a simple interface, same like any other word processing software, which consists of a few editing and modifying tools.
- 13. Students will type the answers in the writing area, and once completed would then only click on Submit Exam Key on the Left Panel. On doing so again a message would appear asking for confirmation. Students have to click Submit again. A message would appear that the exam has been successfully submitted and that the student can leave that page.
- As soon as the students enter the exam page, the page then switches to Full Screen Mode and in no way students should try to modify that, else the exam page would FREEZE and he/she will not be able to continue with the exam.
- The clock timer will display the stipulated duration of the exam and the countdown will start as soon as the student enters the page. The Timer stops as soon as the time gets over, and students have to do the final submission before that.
- During the examination, students have to ensure not to switch to any other tab/window or applications, else the window will FREEZE automatically thus not allowing the child to continue further. Unless it is unlocked by the Administrator/Invigilator.
- Students will enter the EXAM KEY and their First Name, Last Name, Class and Admission Number correctly
  before clicking on FETCH THE EXAM Button. The exam key is case sensitive and comprises of a mix of alphabets
  and numbers.
- Students have to very particular before clicking on the submit button. Once finally submitted, students cannot retrieve back the exam.
